



### **Connecting and operating**

- 1. Power off all devices including your SDI source, HDMI display
- 2. Connect SDI source such as a SDI camera, SDI DVR etc. to the SDI input with SDI cable
- 3. Connect HDMI display such as an HDTV or HD Projector to HDMI out with HDMI cable
- 4. Power on the converter firstly, then power on the source and sink.

### **MAINTENANCE**

Clean this unit with a soft, dry cloth. Never use alcohol, paint thinner of benzine to clean this unit.

### PRODUCT SERVICE

### 1) Damage requiring service:

The unit should be serviced by qualified service personnel if:
